Whilst we have taken measures to ensure that the walk is safe and accessible, some sections of the route include uneven surfaces eg. cobbles and sloped paths. On the day, should the weather be bad, this could result in slippery ground.

Factors Beyond Castlefield Gallery's Control

By agreeing to the conditions of participation, you acknowledge that Castlefield Gallery is not responsible for matters outside of its control eg. loss or damage of your personal belongings, behaviour of the general public, need to make on the day changes to the route, broadly matters of force majeure.

Participant Responsibility

All participants are required to take personal responsibility for:

- Being aware of their own safety
- Considering their physical abilities, health needs, and comfort levels during the walk

If at any point you feel unsafe or unwell, please let a member of staff know immediately. Participants are encouraged to bring any personal aids, medications, mobility supports, water bottles and sensible clothing that they may require.
