


# Environmental Report 2024/25

80% of our Environmental Action Plan goals achieved


- Reduce our carbon emissions by 7%

### Carbon Footprint


31% lower carbon emissions since 2023/24

Total Carbon Footprint: 3.007 tonnes CO2e




#### **Carbon Literacy**

100% of our staff are carbon literacy trained




We are now rolling out in-house training to our board and volunteers!

### Our water consumption compared to other galleries and museums of the same size






29% lower electricity consumption since 2023/24

### Low Carbon Culture


We are an Active Member of the Gallery Climate Coalition

Our Artist Environmental Lead Jane Lawson coordinates the SPARK network of artists wanting to intervene in the climate crisis and is on the GMAST strategy board




### 2038 net zero objective

The gallery has reduced its emissions by 73% since 2013/14

Our goal for 2038: Reduce our carbon emissions to 0.48 tonnes CO<sub>2</sub>e

We are two years ahead of our projected trajectory!



### Our objectives for 2025/26

- Keep our carbon emissions to 3.01 tonnes CO₂e or lower
- Encourage a Low Carbon Culture
- Reduce total waste quantity going to landfill and increase the amount being recycled
- Prioritise the use of sustainable materials



## Castlefield Gallery's medium to long-term objectives

- Mirror Manchester City Council's target of a 50% reduction in emissions by 2025
- Set and make public our zero carbon and environmental objectives and targets
- Maintain 100% carbon literacy training for staff and continue training volunteers, board and contractors
- Provide our team with access to environmental skills and training opportunities where relevant
- Continue to consider how the work we commission can help support our commitment to environmental responsibility and provoke debate.
